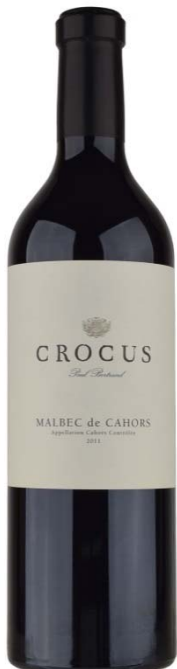

2013 Chateau de Puligny- Montrachet – Puligny-Montrachet

“Bright pale yellow. Ripe peach and spices on the nose and palate. Sweet, pliant and generous but with lively acidity and a floral element giving shape and lift to the wine's fruit. Boasts an attractive balance of sweetness and acidity and finishes with subtle saline minerality. Etienne de Montille did a bit of batonnage in 2013 "to get more fat in the wines, but only where the fruit was ripe enough.” – Vinous

2013 Chanin Chardonnay
Los Alamos Vyd, Santa Barabara, California

Polished and nuanced to the core, this understated Chardonnay is pure finesse. The Los Alamos is the brightest and most vibrant of Gavin Chanin's 2013 Chardonnays. 2012 Chateau Leydet-Valentin St-Emilion Grand Cru
Bordeaux, France \$46

Frederic Leydet runs the family estates that include over 8 hectares of vines in Saint-Emilion and another 8 hectares in Pomerol. Frederic's goal is to achieve the total expression of the terroir, which he successfully accomplishes by practicing traditional wine making methods such as ageing his wines on the lees (sediment) in oak barrels with no racking (the draining of a wine off its lees into a fresh cask or vat). The result is a return to traditional, old style Bordeaux, an approach that is less common these days.

Well-balanced with savory smoked tobacco, dark plum, fig and blackcurrant notes. Toasted oak flavors linger on the finish.
